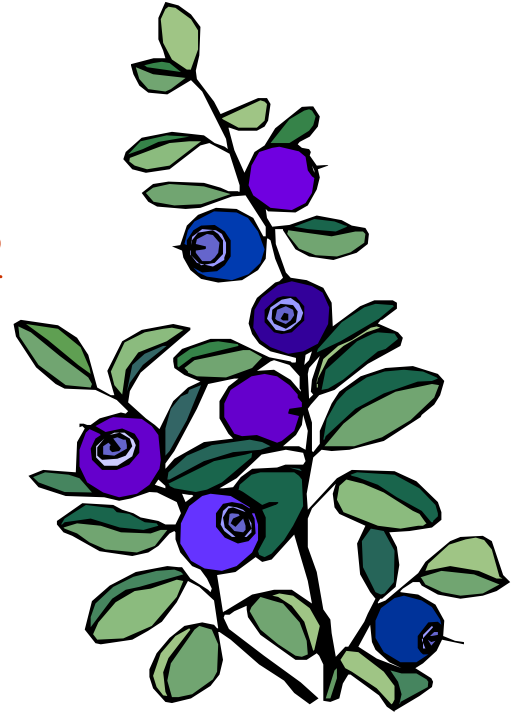


NJAA SPRING EDUCATION TOUR 2010
